7-DAY WILDERNESS DISCIPLESHIP CHALLENGE

Experience God's Presence in the Wild

Day 1: Wilderness Is the Classroom of the Called

Luke 4:1 – "Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, was led into the wilderness..."

Go for a walk in nature. Ask God: "What do You want to teach me in this wilderness season?"

Day 2: Build an Altar, Not Just a Fire

Genesis 8:20 - "Then Noah built an altar to the Lord..."

The next time you light a fire, pray aloud and dedicate your camp to the Lord. Ask: "What do I need to lay on the altar?"

Day 3: Gear Up in the Spirit

Ephesians 6:11 - "Put on the full armor of God..."

As you pack your gear, thank God for the tools of the Spirit: Truth, Righteousness, Peace, Faith, Salvation, and His Word.

Day 4: Steward the Land, Reflect the Kingdom

Genesis 2:15 – "The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden... to work it and take care of it."

How can you honor God's creation today? Clean up, preserve, teach—be a faithful steward.

Day 5: Hear God in the Silence

1 Kings 19:12 - "After the fire came a gentle whisper..."

Find a quiet outdoor place. Sit for 10 minutes in stillness. Ask: "Lord, what are You whispering to me today?"

Day 6: Pass It On

2 Timothy 2:2 – "Entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others."

Who are you mentoring or discipling? Reach out. Pray for them. Share a skill or scripture.

Day 7: Commissioned in the Wild Isaiah 6:8 - "Here am I. Send me!"

Declare: "I am called, trained, and sent—right here in the wilderness."

Write down one action step toward your Kingdom mission in the outdoors.
